

Division Card Benefit To Be Aug. 19 Affair

On the lawns of the Frank and Kenneth Hathaway homes in Norton Hills, bridge tables will be arranged Aug. 19 by members of the Women's Division of the Greater Muskegon Chamber of Commerce. The annual dessert-bridge party of the Women's Division will be held on that date under the direction of Mrs. C. J. Reese, who is general chairman.

Proceeds of the party will be used to further the work on the Harvey Avenue Expressway project, the progress of which was reported to members at a board meeting of the Women's Division officers Wednesday evening. Over 700 plantings have been made this year in addition to grading, filling and clearing work accomplished. Additional plantings will be made in the fall and a project sign will soon be erected by the state.

During the July meeting of the Women's Division, another payment of \$750 was made to the Michigan State Highway Department on the Expressway project. This brings the total payments to \$1,250 and leaves a \$750 balance due, payable within the next two years.

Tickets for the dessert bridge and other fund-raising events to be held at the same time, are now on sale with each member of the Women's Division.

Assisting Mrs. Reese in her capacity as chairman are the heads of various committees who are working toward the success of the annual project. Mrs. Mary Christie heads the committee on tickets and table prizes while Mrs. Iris Vorgias with Mrs. Rehmert Clark, are in charge of tables and chairs.

Mrs. Raymond Fencel directs another committee for the day and Mrs. Dee H. Hollowell is in charge of advertising. Refreshments are the responsibility of Mrs. Richard Reed, while Mrs. Reese, assisted by Mrs. Carl G. Seyferth, are securing the door prizes.
