

## Women organize action group

A group of Muskegon women active in the Women's Division of the Muskegon Area Chamber of Commerce have organized their own political action committee to support the free enterprise system.

The women have set up a Women's Political Action Committee to channel funds to candidates and issues which support their views.

Ruth Stevens has been appointed chairman, Gail Funk, vice-chairman, Elaine McCulloch, treasurer and Gwendolyn v Alexander, secretary. Beverly Curtis will be chairman of the expenditures committee.

"We're trying to improve government by encouraging and motivating

women who support the free enterprise system to take an active part in governmental affairs," Mrs. Curtis said. The women are following the example of the chamber, which organized its own political action committee.
