Mrs. Jane Bowen, chairman of publicity, said the affair will be held Saturday in the Elks Club ballroom on Pontaluna. A cocktail hour with hors d'oeuvres will begin at 6:30 p.m., and dinner will be served at 8. Music for dancing by "The Familiar Feelings" orchestra will begin at 9 p.m. Mrs. Beverlie Curtis is general chairman for the affair, and Mrs. Lucy Nalley is handling tickets. Proceeds will be used for the WD community service projects. The organization maintains a scholarship program and participates in other social and community improvement projects. A contribution of \$2,200 was given to the Hackley House restoration effort.
